Broadening Economic Frontiers

Actually, Chile is a nation that have a healthy economy with clear, consistent governmental regulation and a skilled labor force.

Imports are subject to a flat 11 percent duty; the exchange rate is unified. These measures are part of a development strategy designed to broaden the nation's economic frontiers.

Chile is the worlds's largest copper producer and exporter, the top exporter of grapes, and the second-largest producer of salmon. It is also a major exporter of other minerals, fruit and seafood, as well as wood products and wine. Manufactured goods, professional services, and management expertise from Chile are also marketed worldwide.

An export development and promotion program carries Chilean products to all continents. By widening its market base, Chile has put its foreign trade on a stable footing, reducing its vulnerability to economic swings elsewhere.

T oday, Chile is joining the most important trading blocs in the world. In international economic negotiations it follows a policy of open regionalism, pursued precisely because the country is present in all markets and wishes to maintain this balance.

- Chilean exports grew from USS 4.2 billion in 1986 to USS 16 billion in 1995.
- Over the same period, non-copper exports rose from USS 2.4 billion to USS 9.5 billion.
- In 1995, Chile exported 3,647 products to 167 nations.
- Chilean exports are sold one third to North and South America, one third to the Asia-Pacific region, and one third to Europe.

This is why, for more than 40 years, the Cámara has founded various organizations in order to cover the needs of its workers, that goes from the social security area, and health care, to education, training, and culture. All these now form part of the Social Network of the Cámara Chilena de la Construcción.

In the international scene, the Cámara Chilena de la Construcción is an active member of the Interamerican Federation of the Construction Industry, an institution integrated by the national federations of construction companies and businessmen throughout Latin America, with its main office in Mexico.

The Cámara Chilena de la Construcción, as dictated in its Declaration of Principles, approved in the National Council carried out in August 1994, was defined as a trade association that upholds the values, ethics and principles that are directed by its dedicated humanist vocation to service, which has developed its fraternal, mutually binding, democratic, and participative spirit.

Those who join the institution must share this spirit, and anyone who does not respect these values or principles shall not remain as a member.
